MONROE SENIOR SOFTBALL LEAGUE CODE OF CONDUCT

As a participant in the Monroe Senior Softball League, I agree to conduct myself as a gentleman or lady both on and off the softball field, and that when playing, I will:

Article 1: Abide by the rules of the Monroe Senior Softball League for all regular season, all-star, and charity games.

Article 2: Accept in good sportsmanship the decision of the umpire(s) and my team manager. Only the manager may discuss decisions made by the umpire.

Article 3: Neither taunt nor degrade nor threaten my opponents or teammates.

Article 4: Avoid bodily contact that may cause injury to others or myself. The "slide or avoid" rule will be strictly enforced.

Article 5: Never direct abusive or profane language at officials, opponents, or teammates.

Article 6: Exercise control over my family members and friends to the extent of Articles 3 and 5 above.

Article 7: Neither consume alcohol nor smoke on the field or in the dugout.

Article 8: Only wear my approved team jersey and cap. The integrity of the league and the professional image we wish to convey will not be compromised.

All player violations will be reviewed by the league's Board of Directors and could result in probation, suspension, or expulsion from the league.

Adherence to the Code of Conduct, and in particular as it relates to bodily contact and abusive language, is required by all league members. This Code of Conduct applies to all players, managers, and spectators.
